THUNDER MOUNTAIN ROCKFEST MEETING

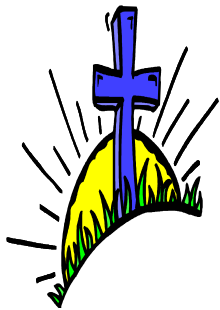
